Comments / Recommendations:

It was a great memorial day. Plastic consisted of water bottle lids and caps; a little bit of glass, variety of paper, lots of little pieces of styrofoam. Many small pieces of styrofoam and small plastic wrappers. Each week seems to be getting better and better...not as much styrofoam or cigarette butts!! :D Many small pieces of styrofoam. Looked like someone had a huge water balloon fight on the overlook at T-street. At least 200 punctured balloons (estimated) were on sidewalk and the street, with overflow to overpass, the trail and the beach. Truly a huge environmental mess. Bottle caps are present often. There appear to be more trash cans but not enough recycling. It would be nice to have a recycling container next to the trash can, otherwise I believe the people will just dump everything into the trash container. Beach was much cleaner than in the past.
