(1) Plastic: sandwich-size bags, 2 plastic cups, 20 bottle caps; (2) Styrofoam: small pieces too many to count; (3) Paper: small pieces of paper and lots of candy wrappers, too many to count. Fireworks, of course after the 4th, apple cores, watermelon rinds, orange peels, one flip flop for a small child, lego figure.

A greasy funnel, (1) Plastic: 35 bottle caps, 6 plastic water bottles, 3 plastic container; (2) Glass: 1 large wine bottle; (3) Paper: Candy Wrappers, Metal Bottle Caps - 6; Broken beach chair, several small, portable barbeque units and numerous coat hangers. 3 flip-flops; 1 heavy plastic base for street cones; 15 zip-lock plastic bags, disposed of a transient encampment hidden behind bushes, beach towel; popsicle stick; sharpie marker; newspaper; mascara tube; t-shirt; underwear; tobacco tin; pencil; string; gum; 8 pieces of crumpled foil; 6 glass bottles; 8 bottle caps, One outboard motor boat seat, Fireworks.

Comments / Recommendations:

(notes taken directly from Data Collection Sheets)

Most cig found at T-street fire pit and benches. 150 cig found around fire pits and picnic tables by north gate. Need help!!!, Real bad between Calafia and end State Park. Most cigs found around fire pits & benches T-street. 2 sand bags of trash in 0.5 mile - Trash from Ocean Festival. There are a lot of spoons and plastic bowls. I don't know if these are from the camps or from the snack bar right there at T-Street. They are using the sand cleaner from Lost Winds past the Pier, so how come I'm picking up so much? I have been picking up way too much trash. I don't know what's happening, but I need more help. 2.5 bags just to go to the pier and back. lots of plastic bottle caps. lots of small styrofoam pieces. One person concentrated around the stairs and she found a lot of small candy wrappers and ballons. Since Linda Lane park drains directly to the beach, we decided to intercept the trash before. We focused on picking up cigarette butts, which we noticed from the previous day's clean up effort. As noted above, there were 700 butts.

Many small pieces of styrofoam and plastic wrappers. Surprisingly less and less cigarette butts!! Many small pieces of styrofoam and plastic candy wrappers. Paper includes larger pieces only... lots of small pieces; Many small pieces of styrofoam and plastic wrappers. There was a man scavenging for cans and bottles on the railroad tracks and on the rocks. He collected approximately 15 plastic bottles and 14 aluminum cans. With a number of scavengers and the recycle bins, we may be finding fewer numbers of plastic bottles and aluminum cans.
