the low tide was gorgeous today... we found ourself noticing how much easier our job is getting... the trash is going down significantly
from trip to trip. yay!!!! :)
1 large dead bird, no one was on duty; we left it alone. Misc. includes. several toys: 3 shovels, GI Joe, dinosaur, Barbie; and child's
hat, large pieces of foam, packs of cigarettes, bands, matches, foil, cigars, pieces of rubber. Many of the trash cans were overturned
probably from high tide. More plastic bottle lids than we have seen to date.
Many small pieces of Styrofoam and plastic wrappers
noted in the unusual item list was 1 live lizard who was trapped in a coors beer can. The can had been tossed in the bushes behind
the bench on lower Linda Lane Park. The can was partially closed, so it appeared as though the lizard was able to enter but not exit
the can. I pried open the closure, turned the can upside down, and the disoriented lizard reluctantly left his aluminum apartment.
He looked fairly skinny, so perhaps he'd been trapped for some time. This is the best thing I've found in my career as a beach cleaner
