We stopped counting straws after we reached 100. Never want to use a straw again. Over 100 plastic bottle caps.

Lots of styrofoam!!! :O!!! bummer.... tons of styrofoam this week.. washed up from the recent storm in the seaweed. We picked as much of it out as we could, but many little pieces we were unable to get. We'll work on it though :

SO MUCH STYROFOAM!! Oh goodness. little bits everywhere :(

Styrofoam is a huge issue after a storm! So much that it is impossible to clean up! Ban the use of Styrofoam in San Clemente period! Plastic water bottle caps and straws are another huge issue. After storms of this magnitude there is numerous amounts of big item trash that need special attention. I myself picked up big items and placed them by the trash cans down by the beach. I would suggest the city stop by and grab these items when they grab trash from these trash cans. The beach is a mess after this storm and I would suggest the city try and set something up to get volunteers down to the beach after recent rains

Styrofoam is a huge issue after a storm! So much that it is impossible to clean up! Ban the use of Styrofoam in San Clemente period! Plastic water bottle caps and straws are another huge issue.
