Lots of coat hangers - 14 of 26 total plastic items were bottle caps; (4) aluminum caps; ribbon attached to balloonbits; (1) tennis ball; (4) band aids; (1) ketchup packet; bikini bottom; 2'x4' plasterboard; (2)sunglasses; (1) belt; (5) flipflops; (1) slice pizza; (1) wiffle ball; (1) cigarette lighter; uncounted were lots of bits of plastic snack packaging; also uncounted were about 1/2 cup of bits of Styrofoam- 5-t-shirts, 3-socks, 1-boogie board leash, 1-tennis ball, 2-shoes, 1-metal spoon, 7-pedros sauce packets, 2-lobster trap metal mesh, 5-ribbons attached to balloons, 4-fast food aluminum containers. *the animal waste was located on lower linda lane cul-de-sac. Comments / Recommendations:

The beach was incredibly clean!! I only picked up seven items- Brenda Miller did not participate in this cleanup. The following participated: Isobel Pelham, Melissa Pelham; Jeffrey Juneau. The latter two names are new members of the team- Helpers on this clean-up were: Isobel Pelham, Gay Morrisette (Isobel's visiting family), Nancy Schoner (transferred from Larry Culbertson's Adopt-a-Beach group) – most of balloons had ribbon attached and entangled in seaweed – many juice box straws (campers?), we need to enforce “no smoking” –we love people asking us what we are doing. One small child ran up to say proudly “I pick up trash too!” We do get lots of appreciation. – too numerous to count (styrofoam & paper)- just a note: the trail was SUPER clean we only found a few items there and really had to look hard for them!!!- most butts were found on the beach trail – most trash by the pier Fishermans washed off pier – That trash finally got picked up thanx -most trash found by pier & No. side pier – Been trying to go farther but there’s been so much trash my back is killing me (coordinator’s comments: this concerns me – admire dedication but health is more important. At the first sign of discomfort – call it a day!) – the trash seems to coincide with the Salsa contest trash that has been washed down and not picked up - most cigs found by fire pit by No. Gate – 35 cig butts found around 2 picnic tables by swings they had a large party last weekend – 15 pens & 200 caps found between south gate and san mateo creek - most cig butts found between calafia stairs and state beach - that one trash can is overflowing again (coordinators comment: have since determined that this particular trash can is responsibility of San Diego not San Clemente).
