Comments / Recommendations:

Cigarettes goin down!! (at least today ☺) Still lots of styro foam though ☹/lots of butts/Styrofoam – counted 520 pieces, then quit counting about ½ way through too numerous to count! (estimate 900 total) Paper – counted 160 then quit counting (est 300 total) / We did not pick up pieces of styofoam smaller than a dime, of which there were many!! We had a great time truly looking at our beach and being in awe about people's lack of awareness of what they are leaving behind. We look forward to continuing on this on-going effort to hopefully raise people's awareness of "leaving only their footprint"!/25 black straws found under Pier, 15 other blk straws found close to pier. Maybe Fishermans can use a vacuum or broom or go under the Pier after washing it down and pick them up/ Note regarding Styrofoam (counted 2000+) These are not small pcs and I pick up a lot more than I add to my totals. The pcs are at least the size of a cup bottom or bigger.
